2018 Junior Golf Program

- 1. Program Overview:** The Willow Brook Golf Course Junior Golf Program is for golfers between the ages of 8 and 17. The program is intended to increase junior's interest and skill in the game, and knowledge of golf rules and etiquette. All juniors will walk the course when playing.
- 2. Program Dates/Times:** See Attached Sheet
- 3. Registration Information/Deadline:** One may register at the Open House held on Monday 5/21/2018 or drop off your required paperwork/ fees to the golf course by Monday 6/4/2018.
- 4. Program Cost:** The cost of the Junior Golf Program is \$50.00 per golfer, which covers golf lessons/ daily event on Monday's only. In addition to the program fee, if your junior golfer is not already covered by a family membership with the golf course, one may be purchased at the following price rates:
 - a. Junior Rate (up through 15 years of age): \$50.00
 - b. Junior Rate (16 - 18 years of age): \$ 175.00
- 5. Lessons:** Juniors will be placed into lesson groups based on their age and experience. Lessons will be scheduled between 8:00 am and 10:00 am, with a scheduled event to take place on the course after.
- 6. Walkers:** We are asking that all parents/guardians sign up for 1 or 2 days to walk the course with the junior golfers. Walkers are vital to the program to ensure that juniors are displaying proper etiquette and safety on the course at all times. Walkers also supervise the activities and make sure that games are being played properly. Please contact Ron Binning to volunteer.
- 7. Lunch:** Lunch, soft drinks and water are available to purchase in the clubhouse for \$5.00. If your junior will be eating lunch, they will need to sign up before heading out to their lesson for the day.
- 8. Pick-up:** Juniors should be picked up no later than 12:15 pm every Monday. Please notify the coordinator if you child will be picked up by someone other than a parent or guardian.
- 9. Rain Outs:** Please call Willow Brook Golf Course (473-3305) after 8:00 am on rainy days to determine if the program will be cancelled for that day.
- 10. Make up Rain Days:** If lessons are rained out (lightening and/or heavy rain), open play for Juniors might still be available later in the afternoon. Call Ron Binning (262-203-3247) or Willow Brook Golf Course (473-3305) for details.
- 11. Junior/ Parent 2-Ball Tournament:** See attached rules and information
- 12. Awards Banquet:** The end of season awards banquet will be held on Sunday, 8/5/2018 from noon until 2:00 pm. Awards will be given for the various events that are played throughout the season. More information will be provided as that date approaches.

2018 Junior Golf Program - Event Calendar

May 21 - Open House: Participants may register at Willow Brook Golf Course from 5:00 to 7:00 pm

June 11 - Least # of Putts: On the course, players will keep track of the numbers of putts they have on each hole. The Junior in each lesson group with the least number of putts for their round, will be recognized at the end of season awards banquet.

June 18 - Medal Play I: Low total scores in each lesson group will be recognized at the end of season awards banquet.

June 25 - Alternating Shots: Each Junior Golfer will be teamed up with another Junior Golfer in their division, and alternate shots to determine the team score for each hole. Winning teams will be recognized at the end of season awards banquet.

July 2 - Flag Holes: Certain holes will have specific competitions on them, such as longest drive, longest putt made and closest to the pin. Winners in each lesson group will be recognized at the end of season awards banquet.

July 9 - Medal Play II: Low total scores in each lesson group will be recognized at the end of season awards banquet.

July 16 - Scramble: No lessons will be held on this date. All golfers must be at the golf course by 7:45 am. Juniors will be divided into teams. Each team member will hit a tee shot and the best drive will be selected. Other team members will move their balls to the selected drive and play their second shot from this location. This process will continue until the ball is holed out. Winning teams will be recognized at the end of season awards banquet.

July 23 - Skills Challenge: Juniors will display their skills as tests are set up to challenge them in various aspects of the game, such as putting, chipping, etc. Awards will be given according to lesson groups at the end of season awards banquet.

July 30 - Rain Day Make Up: Event to be played will depend on which previous date was rained out. If no make up day is needed, we will have open play during the normal lesson times.

August 5 - End of Season Awards Banquet: The end of season awards ceremony and luncheon will be held in the clubhouse from noon until 2:00 pm.

Rules & Regulations

1. **Junior Memberships:** All juniors who are not included in a family membership may purchase a junior membership (application attached). The cost of a junior membership is as follows:
 - a. Junior Rate (up through 15 years of age): \$ 50.00
 - b. Junior Rate (16 - 18 years of age): \$ 175.00
2. **2018 Junior Golf Instruction Fee:** The fee is \$50.00 per junior golfer, which covers golf lessons/daily events on Monday's only. Checks may be made out to Willow Brook Golf Course. Deadline for application/fee is 6/4/2018.
3. **Course Rules:** All course rules will be in effect during the Junior Golf Program. All juniors will walk the course when playing.
4. **USGA Rules:** USGA rules shall govern the play during the Junior Golf Program. These rules will be taught/ reviewed during the program and juniors may be periodically tested on them.
5. **Equipment:** All junior golfers are required to have clubs, balls, tees, a ball marker and a divot repair tool. Let Ron Binning (262-203-3247) know ahead of time if clubs are needed and we will try and make arrangements.
6. **Scorecards:** Make sure your name and lesson time is on your scorecard before you turn it in at the clubhouse.
7. **Carts:** No junior members may drive a cart during the Junior Golf Program. Adult walkers that are supervising may drive a cart, however, all Junior Golfers will walk.
8. **Golf Etiquette:** Proper golf etiquette is required at all times. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - a. No metal spikes or cleats may be worn on the course
 - b. No vulgar language, throwing clubs, or anything else that may be deemed as poor sportsmanship
 - c. Replace divots in the fairway, rake sand traps, repair ball marks on the green and replace the flag in the cup after putting out
 - d. Stay well behind and off to the side of a player teeing off
 - e. Never walk in front or behind a person swinging or hitting
 - f. Do not hit into the group ahead of you
 - g. Allow faster groups to play through, but only from the tee
9. **Junior Members Hours of Play:** Besides during the Junior Golf Program hours, junior members 16 years or older may play during any time open to regular members. Junior members 15 years and younger must be accompanied by a person who is at least 16 years of age. They may play during any open time open to all regular members Monday through Friday. Saturdays, Sunday and holidays - junior members 15 years and younger may only play after 2:00 pm. Please call ahead, as hours of play are subject to change due to leagues, tournaments and/ or other events.
